The challenge is to move people from the poetry to the power of the truth that the story proclaims.

In ancient building, the cornerstone was the key to the survival of the structure. In the same way, Jesus is the key to the structure of the universe. In the providential sovereign plan of God, Jesus is the cornerstone of the universe. "In Him all things hold together" (Colossians 1:17).

In that manger lay the cornerstone of the universe and the only one through whom humanity has any hope of real joy and a future. In fact, Paul reminds us that all creation "groans" in anticipation of its rescue and redemption. All of that hinged on the birth, death, resurrection and ultimate triumph of that baby and His establishment as the cornerstone of Luke's astounding statement in Acts 4.

That is the reason His preeminence is non-negotiable.


